



Guide to the Sudbury Legion Records, 1940–1965 (bulk 1940–1947)

Abstract: The Sudbury Legion Records, 1940-1965 (bulk 1940-1947), 1.75 linear ft., consists largely of record information cards and correspondence from Sudbury service members during World War II to Forrest Dean Bradshaw, collected in his capacity as a committee member of the local arm of the American Legion. The records also contain original copies of the *Sudbury Legion News Letter*, which were sent to those same service members. It was published between March 1944 through October 1945. There are also return-to-sender newsletter mailings within the records.

Acquisition Information: The collection was donated to the Sudbury Historical Society in 1975 by Forrest Dean Bradshaw.

Historical Note: The American Legion was chartered by the United States Congress in 1919 as a patriotic veteran organization. The Legion evolved from groups of World War I veterans into an active and influential nonprofit organization, advocating for the welfare and rights of veterans, providing scholarships and other funding to communities and organizations across the country.

Sudbury Legion Post 191, the local branch of the American Legion of Massachusetts, was chartered on September 3, 1919, and has been in continual operation ever since. Originally located at 415 Boston Post Road in Sudbury, the current headquarters is 676 Boston Post Road.

During World War II, one of the activities of the Sudbury Legion was the creation and distribution of the *Sudbury Legion News Letter*. This monthly publication was sent to service members with ties to Sudbury and was published between March 1944 and October 1945. The committee that produced the newsletter was composed of Roland Hurlbut Eaton, Forrest Dean Bradshaw, and Vivian Albert Fletcher. The issues contained news sent from service members, as well as local news updates.

Scope Note: There are 375 pieces of correspondence, including letters, postcards, holiday cards, and victory mail. These letters offer insight into the experiences of local Sudbury residents serving both domestically and abroad during World War II, and the news that Forrest Dean Bradshaw received in these letters was often used as content for the *Sudbury Legion News Letter*, which was sent to all service members with Sudbury connections. Some of the correspondence (40 letters) that Bradshaw received was in the form of “victory mail.” Officially titled the “Army Micro Photographic Mail System,” victory mail, often shortened to “v-mail,” was a system of condensing mail size employed during the war to reduce the space needed to transport the volume of mail being sent to and from service members overseas. Some correspondence contained ephemera such as newspaper clippings, photographs, Christmas and Easter cards, and unused postcards.

Given Bradshaw's extensive personal, political, and professional involvement with Sudbury, including owning the Bradshaw General Store for forty-one years, as well as serving as Postmaster for over two decades and Town Clerk from 1946 to 1954, he was known to many of the service members with whom he corresponded. The letters often reflect this level of personal acquaintance, and were occasionally also addressed to Bradshaw's wife, Katherine "Kay" Robertson Rogers, or the entire Bradshaw family. For instance, correspondence from Philip Cutler (1940-1947), Nancy Fairbank (1944-1945), Paul Whitney Rhoades (1944-1945), Rodney Duane (1962-1965), Curtis F. Garfield (1960-1962), and Clifford Nelson (1964) appear more personal in nature.

There are also information cards of 248 service members with addresses and biographic updates. Many individuals have multiple records, totaling 722 items. Most of these records are handwritten or typed on small cards, though there are also several on more official "Service Men and Women Record" forms. There are also 39 return-to-sender newsletter mailings within unopened envelopes.

There are 16 original copies of each edition of the *Sudbury Legion News Letter*, which was published between March 1944 through October 1945. There were no newsletters in August 1944, February 1945, or September 1945. There were two separate April 1945 editions.
